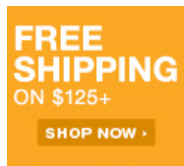

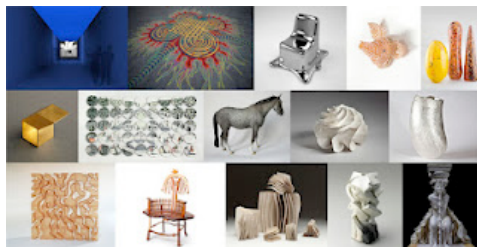

13. Stumped: books made of wood, pages without words by Christian Burchard at Sarah Myerscough Fine Art

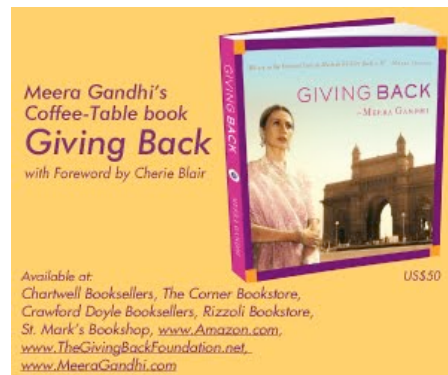
